Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The project involves replacement of two 20-hp pumps, pump guide rails, piping and fittings, cabling, equipment supports, and related materials at the Air Base Parkway Flood Station near the northeast corner of Air Base Parkway and N. Texas Street in Fairfield. The project also involves replacement of two 10-hp pumps, piping and fittings, cabling, equipment supports, and related materials at the State Street Flood Station approximately 90 feet west of the end of the State Street cul-de-sac in Fairfield. The Project will benefit the City of Fairfield community because reliability will be improved for the flood station that drains Air Base Parkway and State Street.
