

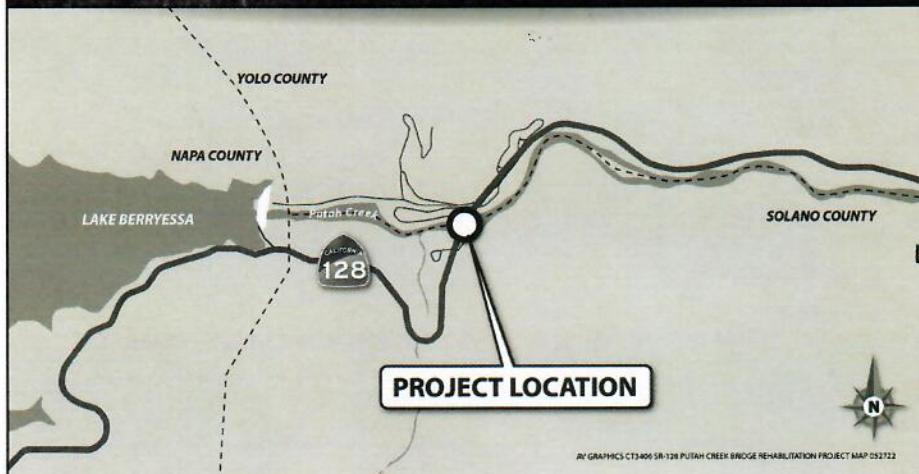

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF AN INITIAL STUDY WITH PROPOSED NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND 4(f) DE MINIMIS DETERMINATION FOR THE PUTAH CREEK BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

The California Department of Transportation (*Caltrans*), the Lead Agency for the California Environmental Quality Act, is issuing a Notice of Availability of the Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration (IS/ND) and preliminary 4(f) de minimis Determination for public and agency review and a Notice of Intent to adopt a Negative Declaration.

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (*Caltrans*) proposes to rehabilitate the **Putah Creek Bridge** located at the **Solano County and Yolo County line** on **State Route 128**. Rehabilitating the bridge would prevent vehicles from leaving the structure, reduce the severity of potential crashes, ensure that the bridge meets current State and Federal design standards, and improve the ride quality for a minimum of 30 years.

WHY THIS AD?

Caltrans has studied the proposed project and has determined that there would not be any significant impacts to environmental resources as a result of the project. The Draft IS/ND and preliminary 4(f) de minimis Determination explain why the project would not have significant impacts to environmental resources or adverse effects on Section 4(f) resources. This public notice is to inform you that the Draft IS/ND and preliminary 4(f) de minimis determination are available for review during the 30-day public comment period.
