

Parking Instructions

- 1. ENTER the Parking Structure from Jefferson St. or Delaware St. (see blue arrows in map)
- 2. PARK only on Levels 1 or 2
- 3. DISPLAY Temporary Visitor Parking Permit to park beyond the 2-hour limit
 - Failure to display may result in a parking citation from the Solano County Sheriff's Office

NOTE: The Solano County issued Temporary Visitor Parking Permit is NOT valid outside the Parking Structure; all street parking time limits are enforced by the Fairfield Police Department.
