

# Solano County Behavioral Health Critical Engagement Programs

## Uplift Mobile Crisis

Acute / Emergent

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### Target population:

- Solano residents who are in a psychiatric crisis or in need of crisis intervention services.
- Currently in Fairfield & Suisun only
- Any Solano resident, regardless of insurance coverage or citizenship status

### Service Provided:

- Phone triage & screening
- In-person, community crisis intervention
- Linkage to resources
- Initiating WIC5150 as needed

### Response time:

- Within 30 minutes

### How to contact:

- Contact 911 and request mobile crisis

## Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT)

Urgent & disengaged

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### Target population:

- Chronically psychiatrically unstable adults who are not engaged in treatment, their condition is deteriorating, *and* it is posing a risk to their safety
- History of psychiatric hospitalizations and/or history of violence to self or others
- Solano County Medi-Cal enrolled/eligible

### Service Provided:

- Assertive engagement to promote voluntary treatment
- Collaboration with treatment providers, family members, law enforcement
- Pursuit of civil court affidavit for court ordered treatment, as needed

### Response time:

- Within 2 business days

## Caminar HOME

Urgent & engaged

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### Target population:

- Adults who are seriously mentally ill and homeless or at risk of homelessness
- Individuals are open to participating in treatment
- Solano County Medi-Cal enrolled/eligible

### Service Provided:

- Intensive case management
- Medication management
- Linkage to benefits
- Housing support and referral

### Response time:

- Within 2 business days

## Homeless Outreach

Ongoing

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### Target population:

- Currently unhoused or at risk of imminent homelessness
- Any solano resident – behavioral health & Medi-Cal enrollment not necessary

### Service Provided:

- Street outreach (in conjunction with law enforcement)
- Pop-up events
- Triage, risk assessment & engagement
- Offer resources & services
  - o Housing, shelter
  - o Healthcare
  - o Linkage to benefits
- Community-based medication mgmt.

### Response time:

- Within 2 business days
